GOSPEL REFLECTION ON THE MOST HOLY TRINITY, Matthew 28 16-20



Inspired by the gift of the Holy Spirit received on Pentecost, the disciples had the courage needed to go forward into Galilee to preach the gospel. Jesus Himself met with them in person on the mountain and gave them further strength. Although they believed, their faith was not without some doubt, it was not that they refused to believe, it was just that there was too much for them to comprehend. In spite of this, Jesus still sent them forth to

make disciples of all nations. He promised that they would not act alone. The guidance of the Holy Spirit would accompany them and Jesus would be with them always. You can be a faithful believer and still have doubts. Faith means the acceptance of God's word even though it is not fully comprehended. It is not necessary to be perfect as disciples of Jesus. It is only necessary to rely on the guidance of the Holy Spirit and the knowledge that Jesus is with us always.
