GOSPEL REFLECTION:



The significance of the Christian baptism resounds in all the readings of this first Sunday of the year. The feast of the Lord's baptism marks the end of the Christmas season and the beginning of the ordinary time of the year. It is striking to see how the church switches from one feast to another. In addition, it brings out the importance of the sacrament of baptism - as the gateway to life in Christ. Armed with the grace of baptism, the Christian faces the challenges of the ordinary life with a view to overcome it. The baptism of the church as instituted by Jesus

Christ is the sacrament of Christian initiation. It is the initiation into the life of faith. Faith guarantees the new life in Christ. Today's readings define faith as loving God. Only the one who is begotten by God through baptism can really understand what loving God means. The ability to see God in the other is the fruit of our baptism. Baptism creates God in our hearts.

The gospel according to Luke presents John the Baptist saying; I baptise you with water, but someone is coming, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to undo the strap of his sandals; he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and

The Christian baptism as mentioned earlier is a life of faith made possible through the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit inspires our faith towards good. The fruits of our baptism lies in our good works. Faith without good works is dead. Thus, the spirit enables our faith to live up to the expectation. The expectations include; enlightening the ignorant, serving the course of right, promoting justice and peace, proclamation of the kingdom by works of charity.
