GOSPEL REFLECTION: Gospel - John 21; 1-19



After the Resurrection, our Lord appears again by the sea of Tiberias. Our Lord cooked breakfast, and after the meal, he questions Simon Peter, 'Do you love me, more than these others do'? Our Lord repeats this question three times, and Peters says, yes Lord, Feed my Lambs. So, Peter confesses his love three times, for through fear he had denied him three times. When our Lord suffered and died in his passion, Peter died as a result of his denial. When our Lord rose from the dead, and out of his immense love for Peter, he raised him.

Our Lord could have said,' How could you after been with me all this time, and you deny me'? Instead, our Lord questions the love Peter has for our Lord and trusts him with the mission feed my sheep. Peter has no benefit to confer on our Lord, by his loving our Lord? If our Lord loves us, it is to our advantage, not the Lord's; In the recent events in Ukraine, people have questioned how could this happen? Where is God? After our Lord's resurrection, he appeared to the apostles, 'Peace be with you' there was no recrimination just 'Peace be with you'. He showed in what way we ought to indicate our love for him. The events in Ukraine challenged us all, with all the hurt, pain and emotions we feel for those caught up in the turmoil of war or the challenges we face in our own life. We still pray we shall have an understanding. What we do know is the Lord he loves us all. Three times Peter was asked, 'do you love me and Peter could not make any other reply but say, Lord, you know I love you. When Peter answered in the affirmative, all our Lord could do was to entrust his sheep to him.

So let us love our Lord, let nothing else matter, only our love for our Lord. It was not just Peter who was qualified to answer but we too are called to answer the question our Lord put to Peter. When we hear this Gospel proclaimed, the question is asked of us 'Do you love me'? We need to see ourselves standing in front of a mirror and hear our Lord asking each one of us, 'do you love me'. What was Peter doing except standing for the Church? Remember, when our Lord asked it of Peter, he was putting the question to us, and he was questioning the Church.
