GOSPEL REFLECTION: The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith but it's not the only moment where we can know Jesus' real presence. When a family gathers for a meal and says grace, Jesus is beside them Whenever we say to someone who's sick, in distress or in trouble, 'Do you mind if I say a prayer for you?', Jesus is right there in our midst. When we make a pilgrimage to Lourdes, Fatima or Rome, Jesus is alongside us. Whenever just two or three of us gather to pray or read the Scriptures, Jesus is right there with us, just as he promised: 'For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with you' (v.20 NIV). This doesn't mean, of course, that Jesus isn't with us when we pray on our own, but when we gather as a Church, as the body of Christ, as believers, he promises that he's there among us. This is very comforting, isn't it? This means that whatever crisis, challenge, tragedy or turmoil we face, when we gather with other believers, Christ himself is there with us.

We can lose sight of God's presence and even take it for granted. When we do this, we can miss out on opportunities of grace and blessing. For example a group of students on a school trip to New York visited St Patrick's Cathedral. Most of them weren't Catholic and hadn't even been inside a Catholic church before. When the group entered the cathedral, they could immediately sense a sweet, peaceful presence, so much so that many of them, non-churchgoers included, wept. This could only have been the present of Christ in their midst.

We need God's grace to enable us not to forget that Christ is present in our midst when we attend Mass, when we receive Holy Communion and when we gather to pray, read or study the Scriptures.

I would like the angels of heaven to be among us. I would like an abundance of peace. I would like full vessels of charity. I would like rich treasures of mercy. I would like cheerfulness to preside over all. I would like Jesus to be present.' (St Brigid of Kildare)
